OR Degree/Diploma awarded by Pracheen Kala Kendra, Chandigarh in the following categories, viz., Sangeet Bhaskar with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet/ Nritya Bhushan with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet Bhushan with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-

year degree course and Sangeet/ Nritya Visharad with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of threeyear degree course
